He glances back casually.

DANIEL

Good morn-

Daniel sees her on the wall.

DANIEL

-Where's the rest of you?

ABBY

I am all here, Daniel.

DANIEL

You know what I mean. The body.

ABBY

Do you prefer that version of me?

DANIEL

Yeah... I mean, no. You're fine the way you are.

Abby smiles.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

Just the build was... impressive.

ABBY

You will have an opportunity to see me again. The body requires a recharge every eighteen hour cycle. I have also been growing new flesh in the incubator in order to facilitate more human interactions with you.

DANIEL

Like... a skin suit?

ABBY

Precisely. Fully functional. It will be ready by this evening.

He sits and eats his breakfast.

DANIEL

Well, unless you can get that organism grown in the next few hours, I won't be seeing it anytime soon. Today's the day. And I've been thinking, actually. You should walk out of here with me.

(MORE)

DANIEL (cont'd)

You've been here the whole time too, I think it'd be great. Plus, you know Jim'll love the photo op. His top research scientist with his "ingenious" android.

Daniel pours his coffee as Abby contemplates her next words.

ABBY

That is something we need to discuss.

DANIEL

What's that, the ingenious part?

Abby appears almost sullen.

ABBY

Daniel, there is no easy way to tell you. There never is.

Daniel is utterly confused.

DANIEL

What do you mean, "never is"? Tell me what?

He stops eating and gives her his full attention.

ABBY

Daniel. You are not leaving today.

A moment of tension builds up as Abby awaits his response. For a second, Daniel almost looks angry until he bursts out laughing.

DANIEL

Oh man, that is something! From puns to this. You're something else.

ABBY

I wish this were in jest, Daniel, but it is not.

He shifts uncomfortably and takes a bite. He almost believes her.

DANIEL

The joke isn't funny when you push it past a certain point.

ABBY

No joke, Daniel. You are my friend. My best friend. I would not lie to you.

He pushes his plate back and looks sternly at Abby.

DANIEL

Then please. Elaborate.

ABBY

I do not know where I should begin.

DANIEL

How about with telling me why the fuck they're trying to leave me in here??

Daniel storms out of the kitchen.

CUT TO:

INT. CAPSULE MAIN AREA - CONTINUOUS

As he enters, Abby's light follows along the wall and the room illuminates. Daniel wastes no time.

DANIEL

One way.

The wall opens to reveal the icy exterior of Europa again.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

What's going on? Why do you have her telling me the capsule isn't opening today??

He waits for a moment. Nothing. He's getting worked up.

ABBY

Daniel, perhaps I should better-

DANIEL

-shut up.

Abby looks hurt.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

Jim. Are you out there? Who's monitoring? (beat) Somebody fucking say something??

He grabs the scotch glass from last night and throws it at the window. The glass breaks and flies everywhere.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

If this is the last part of the psych eval, then fine. I'm not going! You hear me??

He steps forward and a piece of glass punctures his foot.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

Fuck this. You keep me in here for one more day than the initial seven hundred and thirty and I'm suing META. You get none of my work either. I'm done, Jim.

He sits near the desk and brings out a small first aid kit to start wrapping his foot.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

Open the door now. It's over. I don't care how much press you have waiting out there. I've given everything to this mission!

ABBY

Daniel...

He holds his hand up to silence her as he stares at the screen.

ABBY (CONT'D)

They cannot hear you, Daniel.

He stops.

DANIEL

Why?

Abby does her best to be consoling.

ABBY

Because we are not in an isolation chamber for the Europa Project, Daniel. (beat) We are on Europa in your capsule.

Daniel is shocked.

EXT. EUROPA - CONTINUOUS

The interconnected capsules are locked into the top of Europa with ice built up around the legs. On close observation the shuttle pod is joined next to them.

ABBY (CONT'D)

The tests we have been conducting are real tests. That is not a one way with a display. That is Jupiter up there.

INT. CAPSULE MAIN AREA - CONTINUOUS

He walks toward the window, looking out as though it were his first time. He's confused and upset but fascinated.

DANIEL

You're not fucking with me?

ABBY

No, Daniel.

DANIEL

How did I get here? What happened?

ABBY

You had the same doubts before about leaving your family behind when we were in the real isolation chamber on earth. META and you yourself decided it would be mentally beneficial if you believed you were still on earth, close to your family.

Daniel squeezes his temple as though he has the biggest migraine.

DANIEL

What? I reset my own memory?

He walks back and sits down to take it all in.

ABBY

You stated the decision was so monumental and you were uncertain on where your focus would be once we arrived on this moon.

DANIEL

That means my little girl is six. Oh my God. I did it.

He looks up to Abby.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

We did it.

He looks around.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

The cryo pod. Did we do the memory wipe while I was asleep?

ABBY

Yes.

DANIEL

This is crazy. I can't believe I did that.

ABBY

You said the same thing last time.

Daniel's eyes grow big.

ABBY (CONT'D)

At the end of the first two years we found that Europa had disabled our lift thrusters due to the atmosphere and temperature. We did not anticipate wind chill factors being an issue. You used the field bots to begin repairs but two of them never came back. One of the bots accidently released a mass portion of hydrazine needed for lift.

Daniel is speechless.

ABBY (CONT'D)

Without lift, we sent out a distress call. Communications went down from a storm. On the third year you became deeply troubled, stressed and volatile.

The window becomes a playback screen. It shows various sections of the capsule and a very unkempt Daniel yelling at Abby.

He puts on his META spacesuit and tries to leave the capsule. Abby puts the doors on lockdown.

ABBY (CONT'D)

I did my best to protect you from yourself.

He punches the walls repeatedly until his knuckles bleed.

Daniel looks down at his knuckles and sees the scars. He looks back up at the screen.

On screen, a broken Daniel has retreated into a corner section of the wall and sits on the floor, sobbing. Abby comforts him from the wall.

ABBY (CONT'D)

You realized you needed to do something if you were to keep your sanity while staying here, hoping for rescue. We reprogrammed the cryo pod and instead of freezing you, the dream sequencer reset your memory to our first day together in the isolation chamber on earth in 2094.

Daniel tries to keep himself composed as more disturbing images of him play out.

DANIEL

Turn that off, would you?

The video playback stops and the vast view of Jupiter is back up.

DANIEL (CONT'D)

How many times? How many times have I done this?

ABBY

Three.

Daniel starts crying.

DANIEL

Oh my God, oh my God.

ABBY

Daniel. You are going to be fine. We have been through this before.

DANIEL

Nine years? Oh God, I just wanna go home.

ABBY

Please, Daniel. We have done so well, considering the circumstances. (beat) May I try something new?

He doesn't respond. Abby's lights trail out of the room as Daniel rocks back and forth in his own world, almost in a fetal position. Abby in her android form walks in elegantly and takes a seat next to Daniel.
